Also covered is any handicapped adult living in the same household as the member, who requires assistance to manage their affairs.

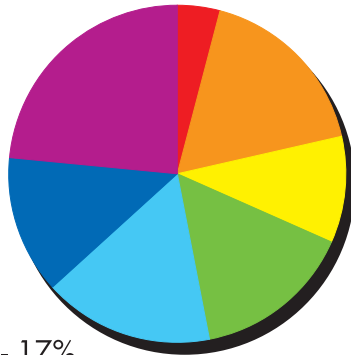

Our fully-managed recovery includes professional services by a licensed investigator trained and certified as an Identity Theft Recovery Advocate. This fully-managed recovery process includes:

- A personal ID Recovery Advocate assigned to research and assess the damage and manage the complete recovery process.
- Credit reports from Experian, Equifax and Trans Union, reviewed by your Advocate, who is Fair Credit Reporting Act certified. This review is designed to identify fraudulent activity.
- Limited Power of Attorney (optional) allows Advocate to perform necessary tasks on your behalf, limited to disputing and reversing documented fraud.
- Advocate will perform research, phone calls, letters, follow-up, and case documentation.
- Advocate will contact and file disputes with creditors, bill collectors, banks, mortgage companies, and agencies such as the DMV, Social Security Administration, & US Postal Service.
- Advocate will work with federal, state and local law enforcement to assist in the identification, arrest and prosecution of the perpetrator.
- **Advocate will continue to work until all fraudulent events have been successfully addressed and expunged!**

+ TYPES OF ID THEFT

People most often think of identity theft in the form of financial theft. However, there are many other kinds of identity theft. This pie chart shows a breakdown of the incidence of the different types of identity theft reported.



- Loan Fraud - 4%
- Credit Card Fraud - 17%
- Bank Fraud - 10%
- Phone/Utilities Fraud - 15%
- Gov't Documents and Benefits - 16%
- Employment Fraud - 13%
- Other - 25%

- **Credit Monitoring:** 3-bureau credit reports, credit monitoring and credit scores from Experian®, Equifax® and TransUnion® in order to review your credit history and to ensure your information is correct and free from fraudulent activity.
- **Internet Monitoring:** Provides you with a proactive tool to detect when your personally identifying information, as well as your unique data or credentials, are being traded by thieves on black market websites, chat rooms and bulletin boards, as well as social networking internet sites.
- **Public Record Identity Monitoring:** Includes monthly monitoring of non-credit-related public records including Social Security number, name and address, non-credit and pay day loans, sex offender records, and criminal and civil court records.
